THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is made on [23 Sep 2019]

BETWEEN:

- (1) Cambridge University Press India Private Limited, having its registered office address at 314 to 321, 3rd Floor, Splendor Forum, Plot No. 3, Jasola District Centre, New Delhi 110025 (hereinafter referred to as "Cambridge" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns); and
- (2) [ITM GROUP OF INSTITUTIONS], of NH-75, Sithouli, Jhansi Road, Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh (hereinafter referred to as ITMGOI) The group has been aiming for providing quality education in Gwalior through its college, university and school. It also aspires to expand in education sector and make quality education available to the students in Madhya Pradesh and other regions in India.

BACKGROUND

- (A) Cambridge is the publishing business of the University of Cambridge and develops and publishes educational courses and instructional materials, and provides related publishing and training services to third parties.
- (B) [ITMGOI is an Educational institute, affiliated with RGPV, Bhopal.
- (C) Cambridge and ITMGOI wish to explore opportunities in which they may collaborate in providing English language solutions and resources to its students and teachers community.
- 1.1 This Memorandum of Understanding (Memorandum) registers the good-faith intention of the Parties to identify ways in which they may collaborate with each other, in relation to the delivery of a project in relation to Empowering students and teachers of ITM group with resources and services to upskill English Language. (the Collaboration).
- 1.2 Further to clause 1.1, in the event that the Parties decide to pursue any aspect(s) of the Collaboration, the terms and conditions of the applicable collaboration shall be the subject of a legally binding agreement or agreements between the Parties at the time.
- 1.3 The cooperation of the Parties shall be subject to the terms of this Memorandum and to the framework of the respective national laws and regulations.

2 PRINCIPLES OF COLLABORATION

2.1 The Parties have agreed the following principles in relation to the Collaboration:

- 2.2 Offering Business English Communication assessments to the students of the institute-
 - Explore the possibility of introducing "Cambridge General English Program' as a tool of strengthen English language at fundamental level and upgrade thereon.
 - Continuous Professional development for the ITM Teachers.
 - Cambridge resources for the ITM schools
 - Explore New possibilities by using Cambridge Resources in other Markets
- 2.3 The Parties acknowledge and agree that, in the event that the Parties enter into a legally binding agreement for any activity pursuant to the above principles, the roles and responsibilities of each Party in relation to the activity will be set out in such legally binding agreement.

ITM may extend the MoU to its group institutes in Gwalior and Vadodara including schools run by the group as and when required with mutual consent.

3 PUBLICITY AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

- 3.1 This clause 3 is legally binding.
- 3.2 Neither Party shall advertise, issue any press release or otherwise publish the fact that the Parties have entered into this Memorandum without the prior written consent of the other Party, except as may be required by law.
- 3.3 The use of the name, logo and/or official emblem of either Party on any publication, document and/or paper is prohibited without the prior written approval of that Party.

4 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 4.1 All copyrights, patents, trade secrets, trademarks, or any other intellectual property (Intellectual Property) owned by one Party prior to the date of this Memorandum will continue to be owned by that Party. Neither Party will gain, by virtue of this Memorandum, any Intellectual Property rights owned by the other.
- 4.2 If the Parties decide to enter into a legally binding agreement, any such agreement will include details regarding the ownership of any Intellectual Property that may be created under such agreement. For the avoidance of doubt, any Intellectual Property created by one Party without the use of the Intellectual Property of the other Party shall be and remain the sole and exclusive property of the first Party.

5 CONFIDENTIALITY

5.1 • This clause 5 is legally binding.

5.2 Each Party undertakes that it shall not at any time after the date of this Memorandum disclose to any person any confidential information concerning the business, affairs, customers, clients or suppliers of the other Party or of any member of the group of companies to which the other Party belongs, except as permitted by clause 5.3.

5.3 Each Party may disclose the other Party's confidential information:

- 5.3.1 to its employees, officers, representatives or advisers who need to know such information for the purposes of the evaluation of the collaboration and the negotiation of any legally binding agreement. Each Party shall ensure that its employees, officers, representatives or advisers to whom it discloses the other Party's confidential information comply with this clause 5; and
- 5.3.2 as may be required by law, a court of competent jurisdiction or any governmental or regulatory authority.
- 5.4 No Party shall use the other Party's confidential information for any purpose other than the evaluation of the collaboration and the negotiation of any legally binding agreement.

6 ANTI-BRIBERY AND CORRUPTION

- 6.1 This clause 6 is legally binding.
- 6.2 ITMGOI understands and acknowledges that Cambridge acts in accordance with the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, UK Bribery Act 2010, Modern Slavery Act 2015 and other applicable antibribery, corruption, anti-slavery and human trafficking laws in the jurisdictions in which it operates (the Acts).
- 6.3 Each Party shall:
 - 6.3.1 comply with all applicable laws, statutes and regulations from time to time in force relating to anti-bribery, corruption, anti-slavery and human trafficking;
 - 6.3.2 comply with Cambridge's Third Party Code of Conduct;
 - 6.3.3 ensure neither it, nor its employees, officers, or shareholders, or any of its suppliers, subcontractors or their employees officers or shareholders, in the course of its performance of its obligations under this Agreement, will engage in any activity, practice or conduct which would constitute an offence under these Acts; and
 - 6.3.4 notify Cambridge immediately if it becomes aware of or has any reason to believe that it, or any of its officers, employees, agents, suppliers or subcontractors have breached or potentially breached any of Cambridge's obligations under this clause. Such notice shall set out full details of any circumstances concerning the breach or suspected breach of TEGV's obligations.

- 11.1 This clause 11 is legally binding.
- 11.2 This Memorandum and the negotiations between the Parties in connection with the proposed Collaboration and all disputes or claims arising out of or in connection with them or their subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims) shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws as applicable in the territory of India.
- 11.3 The Parties irrevocably agree that the courts of New Delhi shall have non-exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with this Memorandum or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).

4. ACADEMIC AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES

4.1 The faculty of ITM and JU may participate in the teaching programs of each other's Institutions in the areas of Engineering, Sciences, Management, Agriculture, Nursing and other areas of mutual interest on request and subject to mutual convenience. For the mutual benefit of the two institutions, ITM and Jiwaji University, there will be exchange of faculty members/research students/PG students as per mutual convenience. Honorarium for the lectures delivered will be paid by respective Institutions as per Institutional norms.

4.2 The faculty of ITM and faculty members of Departments of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Engineering, Management, Biology based subjects etc. of Jiwaji University will work towards joint research projects in areas of mutual interest, thereby mutually using leading research facilities developed in ITM and Jiwaji University.

4.3 Also, both the ITM Jiwaji University would extend technical assistance to to each other in digitalization and developing online services in administrative as well as academic sectors.

4.4 The Faculty working at the ITM/JU shall be recognized as Ph. D supervisors/co-supervisors with due approval of the competent statutory bodies. The candidate may opt for co-supervisors from either of the universities (ITM/JU) as deemed necessary for the research work. Provided faculty members of the ITM/JU should fulfill the qualifications to become a research co-supervisor as per their Ordinances.

4.5 Both the parties agree to cooperate in the design of academic courses and programs. Training programs of specific duration may be organized by mutual consent for the benefit of students enrolled in both Universities.

4.6 Both Universities agree to extend technical assistance to each other in setting up of Incubator in desired fields.

4.7 Ph.D. students of both University may be allowed to carry out partial research work in partner University with the consent of respective Deans of Schools/Heads & departments and approval of VC/Director. Both are agree to extend their research facilities and expertise to research students depending on the resource available. While carrying out studies analysis, shall be governed by ITM/JU rules as applicable.

4.8 For any IPR data and information resulting from collaborative research activities under this MoU, shall be shared as per the separate agreement to be executed on case to case basis.

5. DURATION AND OTHER TERMS OF MoU

5.1 The MoU will be effective for a period of 10 years from the date of signature. The duration may be extended with the consent of both the parties under mutually agreed terms and conditions. The MoU may be terminated by either party by giving one year notice in writing.

5.2 Nodal officers may be designated by both parties to coordinate and function as per the modalities of MoU






